1. Assuming you have not used DC++ on your computer before, start up DC++. You should see a dialog like the one below:



Make sure to change the it to "Always allow connections to this program on all ports"

2. Next, you will see the dialog box below:



Make sure to change it to "Permit" and check "Always use this action" 3. Now DC++ should be set up.

If you did **not** get these popups, then you may need to manually configure the firewall to allow DC++ traffic.

1. Open up the main screen for the firewall and click Configure
